JDN History, Part 6

Max Neuhaus

(1.1.1900 - 5.2.1984)



Max Neuhaus expanded the trading with hoists systematically by clever advertising. The profits of the current business were reinvested in new machinery. In 1923 the workshop was extensively enlarged. The first powered transmission driven machines were acquired. After the second world war the underground coalmines continued to request Neuhaus equipment. In order to fulfil this increasing demands a new workshop was built in 1952.

How are JDN Air Hoists protected against overload?

JDN Air Hoists comply with the machine directive and therefore have an overload protection on all products with SWL's starting from 1000 kg. The sophisticated control ensures that in case of overload the hoist stops. To unlock the stopped hoist it has to be lowered by the pendant control to release the latched overload device.

- The pneumatic motor simply stops without any damage
- No overheating in stall torque or jamming
- No special protection facilities like PTC elements required
